

Lindenwood University Student Health Center Immunotherapy Protocol

Process for the BarnesCare clinic at Lindenwood University to provide immunotherapy.

- I. The student will need to contact BarnesCare's Lindenwood clinic with the need for immunotherapy with the below information.
- II. The student's Allergist/Immunologist will need to be contacted by the Student Health Center to verify treatment.
- III. The Allergy office will need to provide:
 - a. A list of ingredients in the injections
 - b. The protocol for administration – dose, timing, etc.
 - c. The patient's consent to the injections signed in the Allergist's office listing risks vs benefits is preferred but not required
 - d. The student will need to make an appointment in the clinic
- IV. IV. Patient must be observed in the Student Health Center for 30 minutes following injection.
- V. If an anaphylactic reaction occurs, the Student Health Center is to administer an appropriate dose of epinephrine and Benadryl. Albuterol and/or steroids may also be provided. The patient is to lay flat. 911 will be called to activate EMS for the patient.
